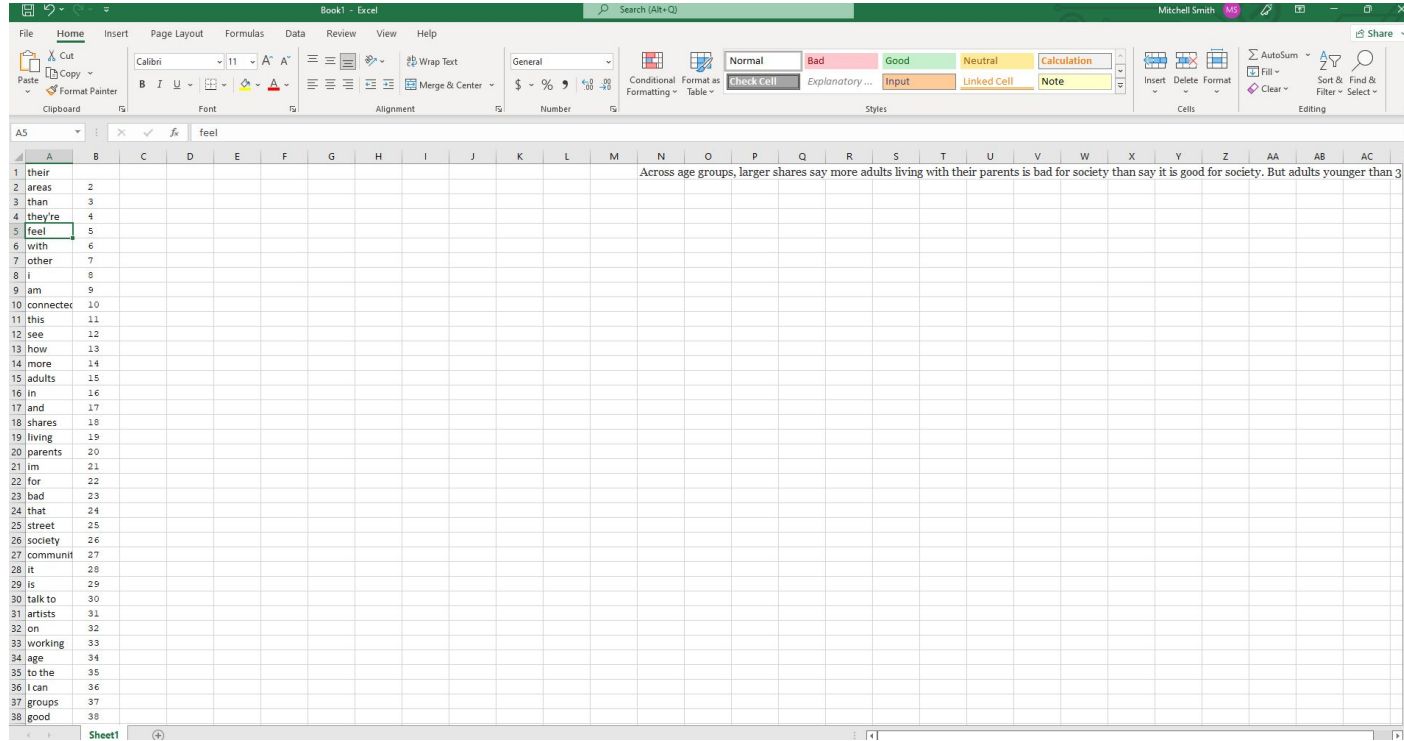

I started by taking a WEAR TV article and a Pew Research Center article and selecting a sentence from each. I then put the individual words into excel and randomized the order.

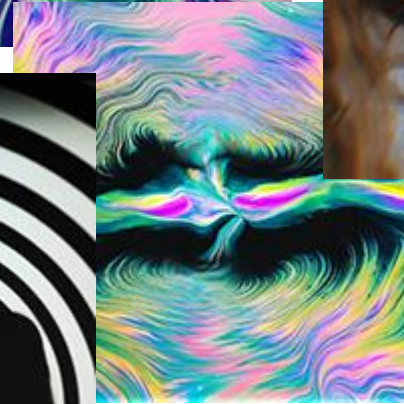
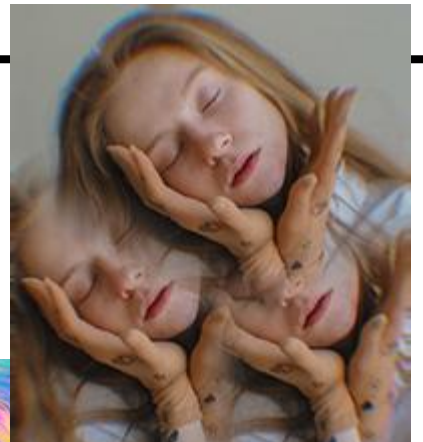
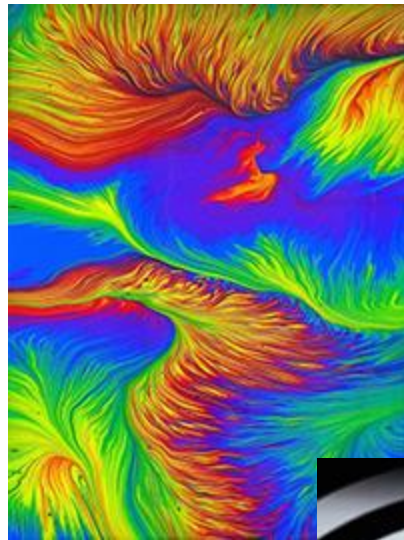
These were the results. At first, there were not many sentences that stuck out to me.

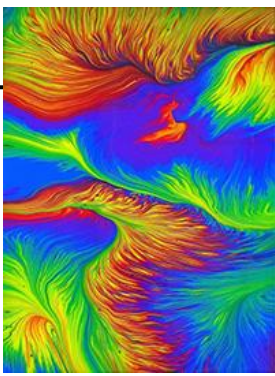


This sentence is a little rough, but I think it is the best prompt from this process. I am not sure what direction I will go, but I think this sentence is a good starting point.

1st Page idea 1:

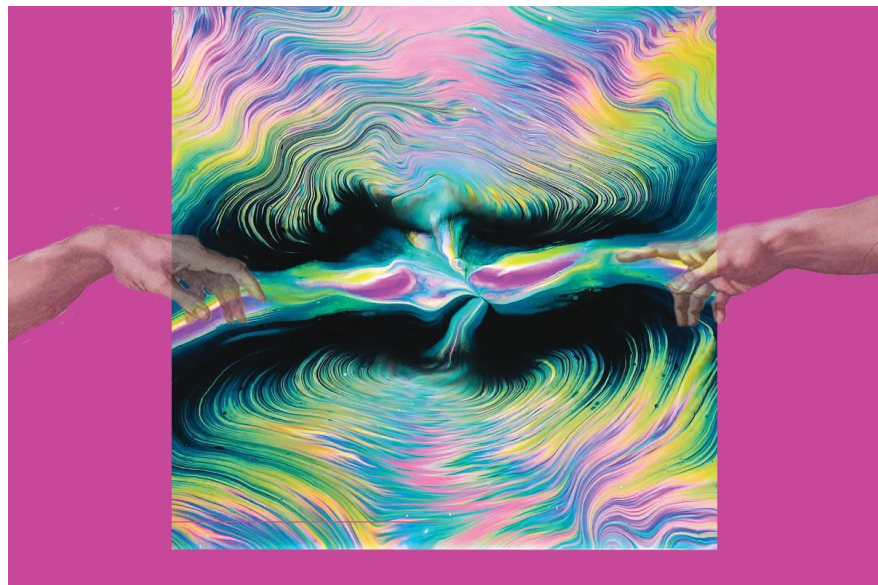
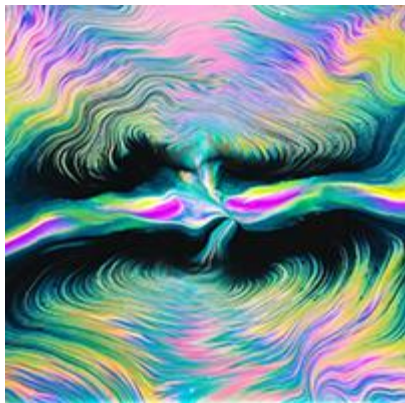

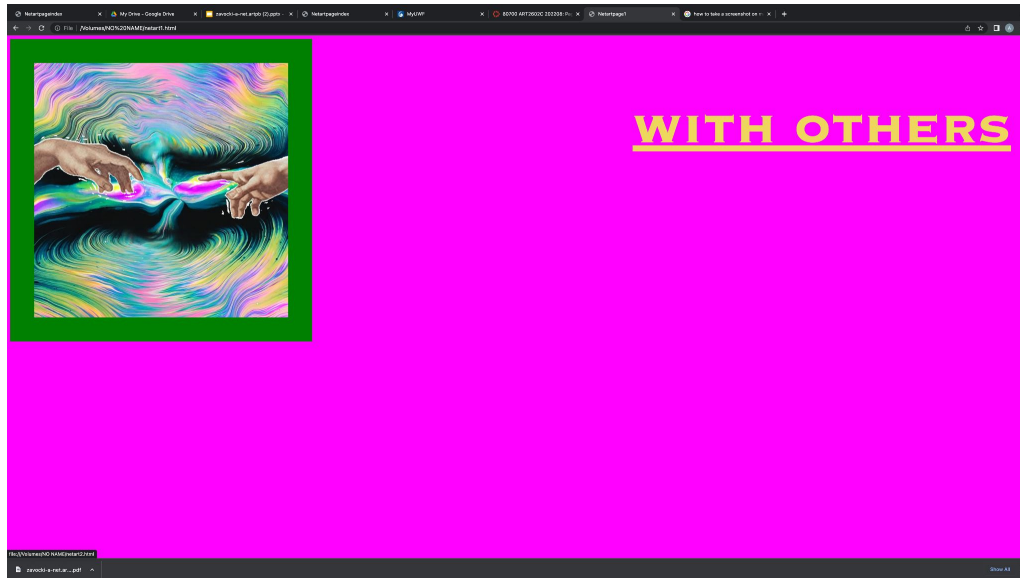


HTML Page Idea 5:

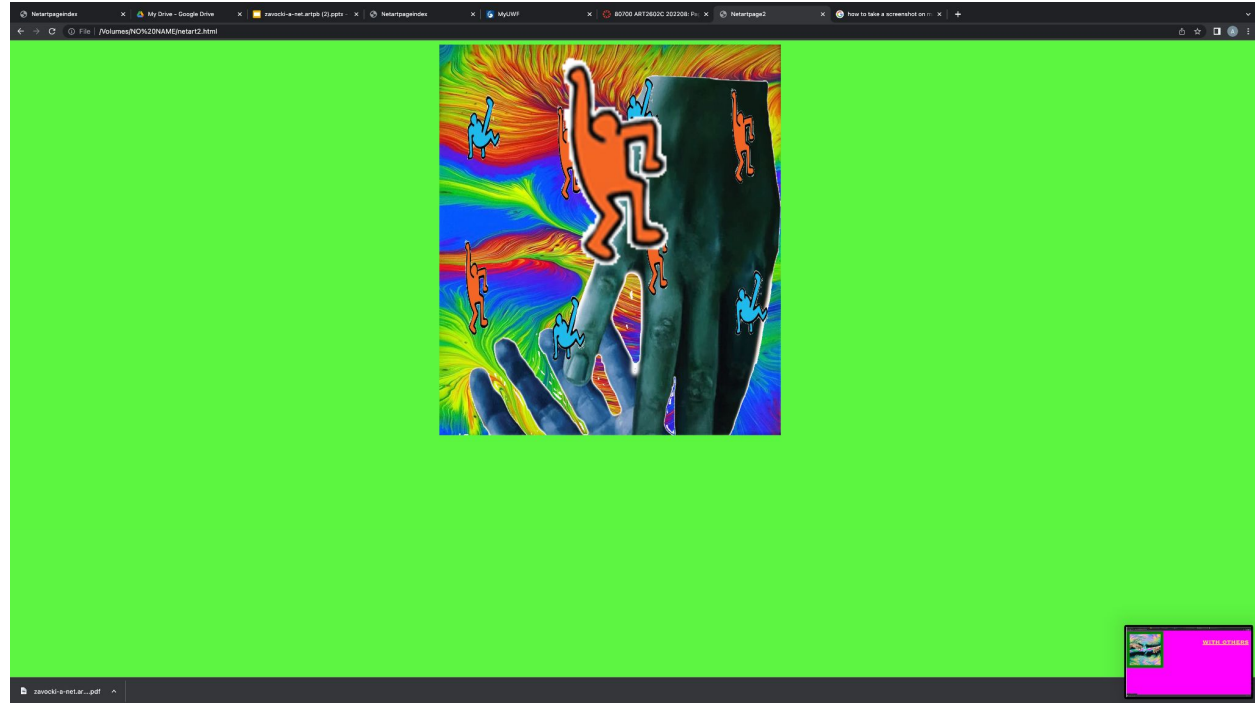
1st page

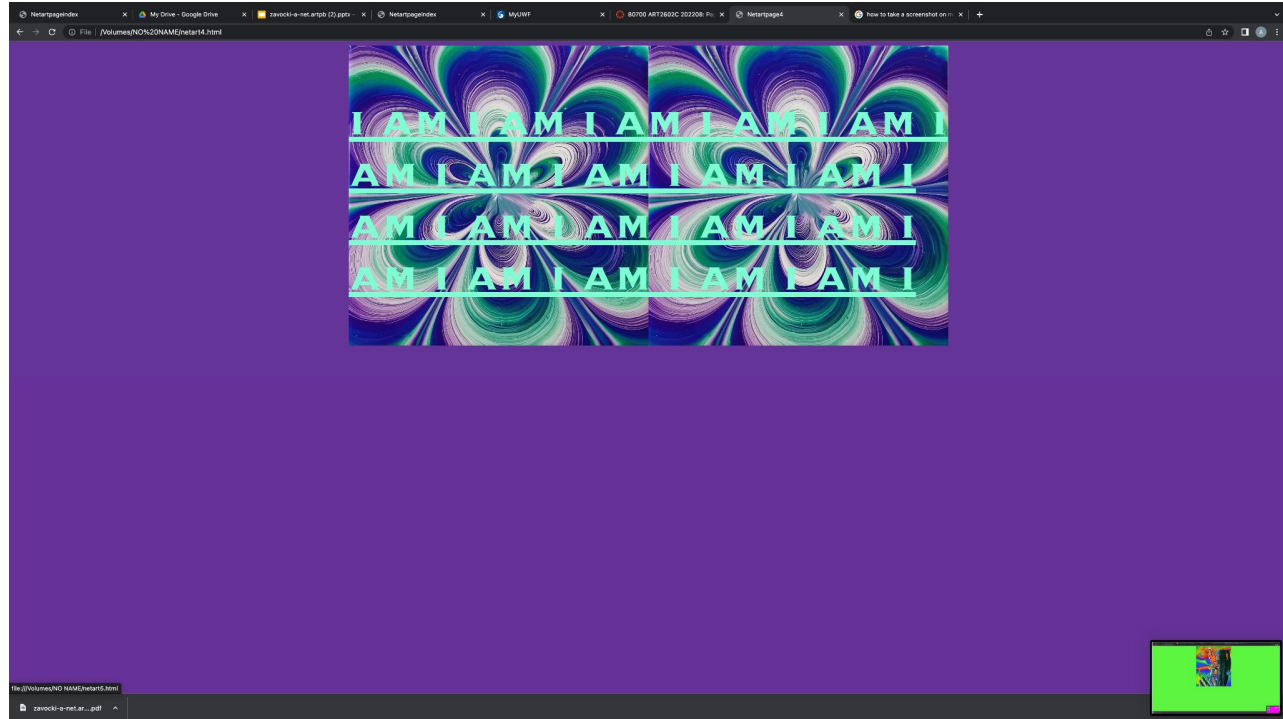
2nd Page

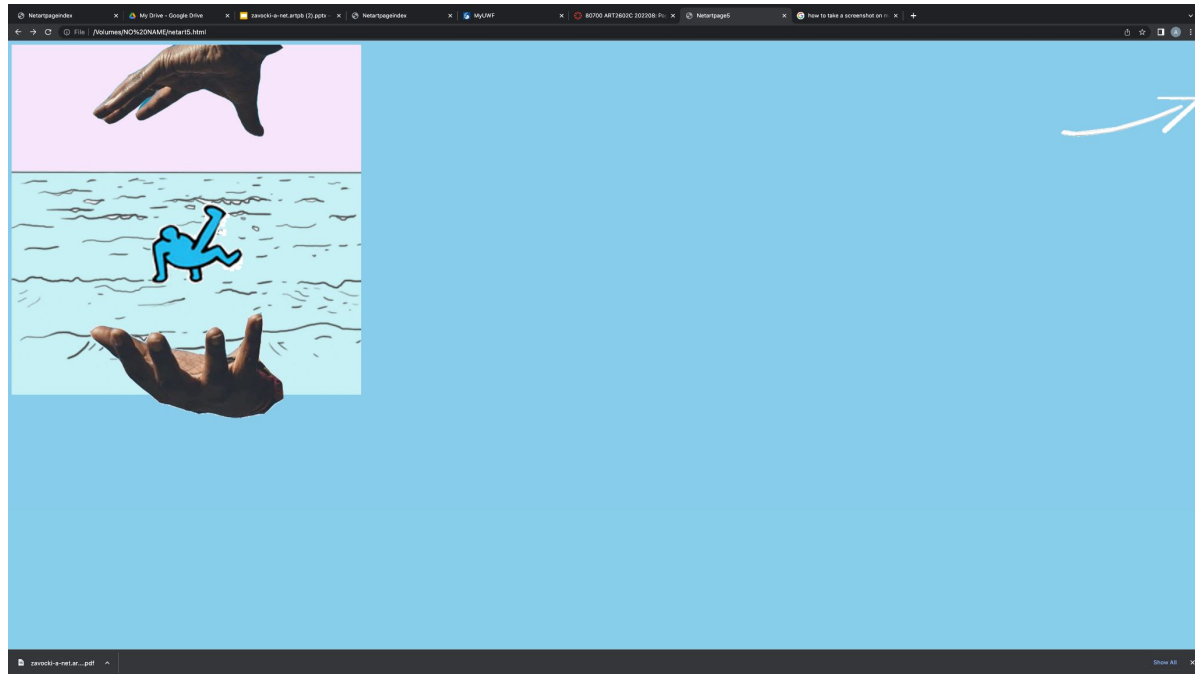
3rd Page

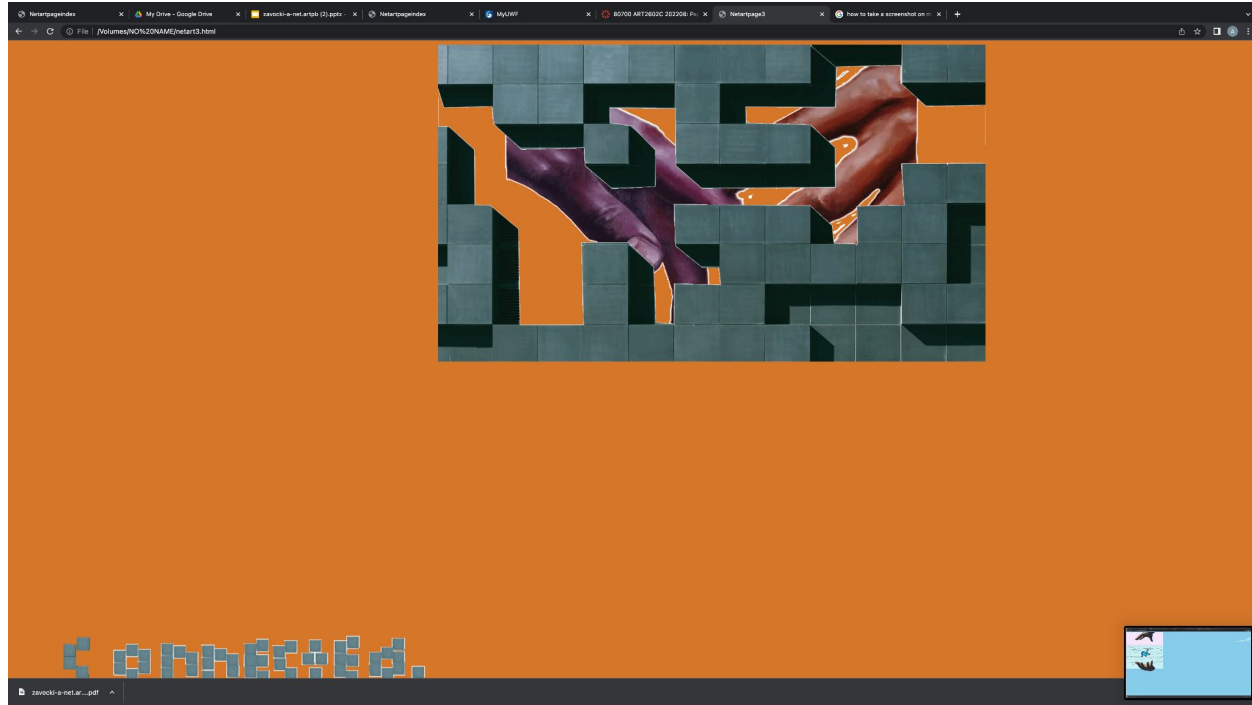
4th Page
