Thursday announced rainforests revealing the worlds reflection


Artist Statement

The prompt mentions rainforest, and I found it no better fit than to add in my favorite animal. Brainstorming :


Mapping out my first page :

- I need to make the calendar myself using CSS (look at css painting)




Mapping out my first page :

- Incorporate household things that correlate with the theme of the pages it is linked to




Mapping out my Storyboard :


Forest Page


